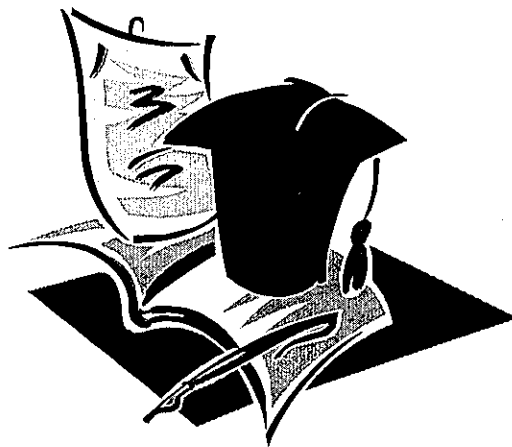
Dear Mrs. Causey,
